1177, S.D. 1, entitled:

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds from the
Works of Art Special Fund for four full-time equivalent positions
in the State Foundation for Culture and the Arts. These new
positions are established within the Foundation and funded through
a Foundation special fund in response to the Auditor's findings in
Report No. 14-11, that the Foundation is unable to adequately
fulfil its mission and manage its assets, both financial and
artistic, due partly to insufficient staff and insufficient
institutional expertise.


The State Foundation on Culture and the Arts supported this
