Friday, March 13, 2015

The House of Representatives of the Twenty-Eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2015, convened at 12:06 o'clock p.m., with Vice Speaker Mizuno presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Representative Kaniela Ing, after which the Roll was called showing all Members present with the exception of Representative Oshiro, who was excused.
