THIRTY-FOURTH DAY

Tuesday, March 24, 2015

The House of Representatives of the Twenty-Eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2015, convened at 12:08 o'clock p.m., with Speaker Souki presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Reverend Paul Schuler and Ms. Pikake Kimata of City Church of Honolulu, after which the Roll was called showing all Members present with the exception of Representatives Har, Ing, Takumi and Tupola, who were excused.

By unanimous consent, reading and approval of the Journal of the House of Representatives of the Thirty-Third Day was deferred.
