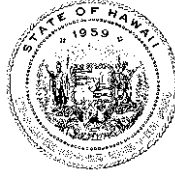

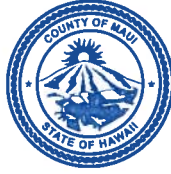

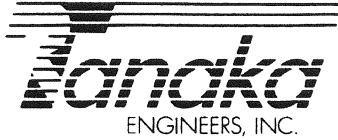
The ILWU Local 142 supports the nomination of Kent M. Hiranaga to serve on the Land Use Commission.
