The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) strongly supports Governor's Message (GM) 818 to appoint Marjorie Ziegler to the Legacy Land Conservation Commission (Commission) for a term to expire 6-30-2017.

Marjorie Ziegler is a resident of Oahu and qualifies as a person possessing membership in an environmental organization organized in the State, as required under Section 173A-2.4, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Ms. Ziegler is a member and Executive Director of the Conservation Council for Hawai'i, a local organization dedicated to protecting native Hawaiian plants, animals, and ecosystems for future generations. Previous to Ms. Ziegler's 15 years with the Conservation Council for Hawai'i, she worked or volunteered for a number of environmental organizations within the State, including KAHEA: The Hawaiian-Environmental Alliance, the Hawaii Audubon Society and the Sierra Club Hawaii Chapter. Ms. Ziegler is a graduate of the University of Hawai'i Mānoa with a degree in geography with a focus on rare and endangered Hawaiian species. She has recently served for seven years on the City and County of Honolulu's Clean Water Natural Lands Commission, a program that provides conservation land acquisition funding at the county level.

With her combination of expertise in Hawaii's environmental issues, her knowledge of local geography, natural resources, and wildlife, and her experience in reviewing proposals for land acquisition fund, Ms. Ziegler is exceptionally qualified to serve on the Legacy Land Conservation Commission. The Department strongly supports GM 818 on the appointment of Marjorie Ziegler to the Legacy Land Conservation Commission and looks forward to working with Ms. Ziegler.
