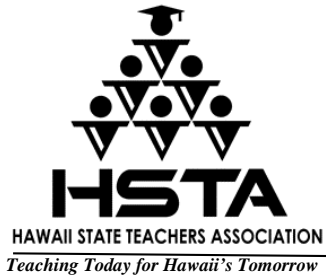

The Department of Education (DOE) supports SCR No. 110, recognizing the advantages of consolidating multiple DOE offices in one more centralized facility. Whereas, it is expected that only a portion of the cost of constructing the new office facility would be offset by leveraging DOE asset, it is recommended that initial funding be established to engage development consultants to determine the associated cost for developing the parcel of land on California Avenue. This pre-development study would determine the real value of those DOE assets to be leveraged and the amount of supplemental funds, if any, which the DOE would need to contribute to ensure the success of the project.
