**URGING ALL STATE AGENCIES TO RETROFIT STREET LIGHTS AND OTHER
OUTDOOR LAMP LIGHTING FIXTURES WITH ENERGY EFFICIENT LIGHT-
EMITTING DIODE BULBS, WHERE APPROPRIATE**

Chair Gabbard, Chair Dela Cruz, and members of the Committees, thank you for the opportunity to submit written testimony on S.C.R. 140 / S.R. 84.

The Department of Accounting and General Services (DAGS) supports the intent of these resolutions and notes Act 287, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, which implements requirements for retrofitting existing state fixtures similar to those identified in these resolutions. DAGS has assisted the Hawaii Public Housing Authority with retrofitting parking lot lights and wall-mounted exterior lights in their Wahiawa facilities, and we are in the process of planning the retrofit of lighting for DAGS – Automotive Division parking lots and parking structures with LED fixtures, where feasible.
