We simply asked for Administrative rules, same as is needed in every government and private organization, anywhere. These rules will help clarify expectations so we can move forward in a pono way. There should be no gaps left for ambiguities, personal interpretations, and unchecked decision-making, such as rerouting the constituency from "moku" to " 'ahupua'a" because "moku" doesn't fit the politics of the moment.
