As the Honolulu rail transit continues on West Oahu/Farrington Highway and Kamehameha Highway Guide ways, Kiewit and H.A.R.T will continue to provide updates to our community on construction activities. In the coming months the underground shafts and columns in East Kapolei is anticipated to reach Waipahu. They are also progressing with the relocation of utility lines along Farrington Highway.

We continue to ask the community to be aware and observe all traffic signs to ensure the safety of motorist and those working on the project. Also, be aware of traffic changes including the following: lane or road closures, detours, temporary bus stop relocation, and sidewalk closures. Community members who live or work close to construction activities may experience increase noise levels. Construction activities can be expected during the following hours:
