A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 431:21-119, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+] §431:21-119[+] Issuance of new policies; removal of
- 4 moratorium. If residential property insurance is unavailable,
- 5 as determined by the commissioner, due to a moratorium on the
- 6 issuance of policies on property situated in lava zones where
- 7 the mayor of the county of Hawaii has issued a proclamation
- 8 declaring a state of emergency exists due to the threat of
- 9 imminent disaster from a lava flow, the association shall remove
- 10 its moratorium. Upon the moratorium's removal, the association
- 11 shall offer new policies and may provide a waiting period of no
- 12 longer than six months for the policy coverage to take effect;
- 13 provided that the residential property in the lava zone does not
- 14 have current insurance."
- 15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
