A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RESPIRATORY THERAPISTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that chapter 466D, Hawaii.
- 2 Revised Statutes, establishes the regulation of respiratory
- 3 therapists, which is set to repeal on June 30, 2016.
- 4 Furthermore, pursuant to chapter 26H, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 5 the auditor is required to evaluate newly enacted occupational
- 6 regulatory programs prior to each board's, commission's, or
- 7 regulatory program's repeal date.
- 8 The legislature further finds that an auditor's report from
- 9 June 2015 finds that the regulation of respiratory therapists is
- 10 reasonably necessary to protect the health and safety of
- 11 consumers. The findings also note that licensure of respiratory
- 12 therapists is consistent with other health-related occupations,
- 13 such as doctors and nurses, and is warranted because consumers'
- 14 health and safety may be jeopardized by the nature of services
- 15 offered by respiratory therapists. Furthermore, every state
- 16 except Alaska regulates respiratory therapists.
- 17 The purpose of this Act is to make permanent the regulation
- 18 of respiratory therapists under chapter 466D, Hawaii Revised



- 1 Statutes, which will ensure the health and safety of Hawaii
- 2 residents and visitors.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 26H-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 . amended to read as follows:
- 5 "§26H-4 Repeal dates for newly enacted professional and
- 6 vocational regulatory programs. (a) Any professional or
- 7 vocational regulatory program enacted after January 1, 1994, and
- 8 listed in this section shall be repealed as specified in this
- 9 section. The auditor shall perform an evaluation of the
- 10 program, pursuant to section 26H-5, prior to its repeal date.
- 11 [(b) Chapter 466D (respiratory therapists) shall be
- 12 repealed on June 30, 2016.
- 13 (b) Chapter 436H (athletic trainers) shall be
- 14 repealed on June 30, 2018.
- 15 [(d)] (c) Chapter 465D (behavior analysts) shall be
- 16 repealed on June 30, 2021."
- 17 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2016.
