A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CERTIFIED NURSE AIDES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Act 93, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, was
2	enacted to improve the efficiency, capacity, and quality of
3	state health care services provided by the department of human
4	services and the department of health, as they relate to various
5	health care services, by transferring to the department of
6	health office of health care assurance on July 1, 2014, the
7	programs of the department of human services relating to home
8	and community-based case management, community care foster
9	family homes, and adult day care centers. As a result, certain
10	statutory provisions are no longer applicable to the department
1	of human services. The purpose of this Act is to delete
12	duplicative or obsolete statutory provisions.
13	SECTION 2. Section 457A-1.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended by amending the definition of "state-licensed or state-
15	certified health care settings" to read as follows:
16	""State-licensed or state-certified health care settings"
17	means health care settings, other than [a] medicare or medicaid

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1	certified nursing facilities, which are regulated by the
2	department of health [or the department of human services]."
3	SECTION 3. Section 457A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
5	"(c) The director of human services shall implement this
6	chapter in accordance with 42 United States Code sections 1395i
7	3 and 1396r, that relate to[+
8	(1) Training training programs for nurse aides and
9	recertification; provided that recertification shall
10	be required not less than every two years and the
11	number of continuing education hours required for
12	recertification shall not exceed twenty-four hours,
13	except as specified by federal law[; and
14	(2) Disciplining of certified nurse aides employed in
15	health care settings licensed or certified by the
16	department of human services]."
17	SECTION 4. Section 457A-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
18	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
19	"(b) The director shall issue certificates to qualified
20	nurse aides and shall be responsible for maintenance of an up-
21	to-date nurse aide registry that shall include the names of
22	certified nurse aides, their places of employment, and all

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1 information that is [required to be] reported by the department 2 of health and the department of human services. The director's 3 role, with regard to the disciplining of certified nurse aides, 4 shall be limited to the placement into the certified nurse aide 5 registry of all information and substantiated findings from the 6 department of health [and the department of human services], as 7 required by 42 United States Code sections 1395i-3 and 1396r, 8 and the department of human services, within ten working days of 9 the finding, which information shall permanently remain in the 10 registry except if: The finding was made in error; 11 (1) 12 (2) The individual is found not guilty in court; or 13 The State receives notification of the individual's (3) death." 14 15 SECTION 5. Section 346-47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 repealed. 17 ["[§346-47 Certified nurse aides; investigations of abuse and neglect.] The department shall adopt rules pursuant to **18** 19 chapter 91 relating to: (1) The investigation of: 20

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1	(A) Abuse or neglect by a certified nurse aide
2	working in a health care setting licensed or
3	certified by the department; and
4	(B) Misappropriation of an individual's property by a
5	certified nurse-aide working in a health care
6	setting licensed or certified by the department;
7	and
8	(2) Action taken against a certified nurse aide as a
9	result of an investigation pursuant to paragraph
10	(1). "]
11	SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
13	SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
