ACT 090 S.B. NO. H.D. 1 C.D. 1

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to address the
- 2 . development or expansion of a forensic facility of the
- 3 department of health.
- 4 The legislature finds that the department of health is
- 5 proposing to undertake the construction of a new building at the
- 6 Hawaii state hospital. The new building is of high priority
- 7 because of census and health and safety issues at the hospital.
- 8 To expedite the development, the department of health and
- 9 department of accounting and general services intend to use the
- 10 design-build process. However, the legislature finds that the
- 11 department of health and department of accounting and general
- 12 services may need more flexibility to move quickly.
- 13 Thus, the legislature authorizes the governor, through this
- 14 Act, to negotiate directly with a person to develop or expand a
- 15 forensic facility of the department of health. The legislature
- 16 intends that the governor may negotiate and award a contract to
- 17 develop or expand a forensic facility without necessity of
- 18 compliance with the procurement code.

- 1 This Act is based on section 353-16.35, Hawaii Revised
- 2 Statutes, under which the governor is authorized to negotiate
- 3 the development or expansion of a correctional facility.
- 4 Although that statute has never been used, it serves as a model
- 5 for further expediting the construction of a new forensic
- 6 facility for the department of health.
- 7 The legislature notes that this Act provides an extended
- 8 review and comment period for an environmental assessment or
- 9 environmental impact statement. The legislature has included
- 10 this provision to balance the expedited development or expansion
- 11 process by providing the opportunity for more public scrutiny of
- 12 a proposed forensic facility.
- 13 SECTION 2. Chapter 334, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 15 designated and to read as follows:
- 16 "\$334- Development or expansion of a forensic facility
- 17 of the department of health. (a) Notwithstanding any other law
- 18 to the contrary, the governor, with the assistance of the
- 19 director, may negotiate with any person for the development or
- 20 expansion of a forensic facility of the department; provided
- 21 that if an environmental assessment or environmental impact

1	statement	is required for a proposed site or for the expansion						
2	of the forensic facility under section 343-5, then							
3	notwithstanding the time periods specified for public review and							
4	comments under section 343-5, the governor shall accept public							
5	comments for a period of sixty days following public							
6	notification of either an environmental assessment or an							
7	environmental impact statement.							
8	(b)	Any development or expansion proposal shall address						
9	the construction of the forensic facility separate from the							
10	operation	of the facility and shall consider and include:

- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
