# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JOINT FORMULARY ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the joint formulary
2	advisory committee established by the department of commerce and
3	consumer affairs should be repealed because it is obsolete and
4	unnecessary in recommending the applicable formulary for
5	advanced practice registered nurses with prescriptive authority.
6	The board of nursing is the authority that determines the
7	qualifications and scope of practice of advanced practice
8	registered nurses with prescriptive authority, and the board is
9	already the authority that determines the applicable formulary
10	or exclusionary formulary for licensees under its authority. If
11	necessary, the board of nursing may consult with other boards,
12	such as the board of pharmacy or Hawaii medical board, on
13	questions pertaining to prescription drugs. Other resources,
14	such as the National Council of State Boards of Nursing, also
15	have information on other states, nurse practice acts.
16	The purpose of this Act is to repeal the joint formulary
17	advisory committee established by the department of commerce and

consumer affairs.
