A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENTAL TRAVEL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 78, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as follows:
4	"§78- Payment of approved travel costs for public
5	officers and employees. (a) This section shall apply to all
6	approved travel costs incurred by an officer or employee of the
7	State or a county in connection with the official business of
8	the respective jurisdiction.
9	(b) Subject to subsection (d), the State and the counties
10	may pay approved travel costs directly to:
11	(1) The vendor providing the goods or services involved;
12	<u>or</u>
13	(2) The officer or employee for whom the approved travel
14	costs are to be paid, by way of a cash advance prior
15	to the date of purchase, unless the officer or
16	employee affirmatively agrees to loan the State or a
17	county the money for the travel costs and be

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1	reimbursed after the officer or employee pays for the
2 ·	travel costs.
3	(c) This section shall not be construed as precluding the
4	reimbursement of approved travel costs to an officer or employee
5	upon completion of travel for any costs that for any reason were
6	not paid by the State or the county, as applicable, in
7	accordance with subsection (b).
8	(d) As pertains to the officer or employee incurring
9	approved travel costs, whenever there is a conflict between a
10	collective bargaining agreement and this section, the terms of
11	the collective bargaining agreement shall prevail.
12	(e) For the purposes of this section, "approved travel
13	costs" means any determinable costs of travel for official state
14	or county business approved by the respective jurisdiction and
15	supported by a written invoice. The term includes the costs of
16	transportation to and from a destination point, between
17	destination points, or within a destination point; event
18	registration fees; per diem allowances; and any other necessary
19	costs related to the travel.
20	(f) An employer shall not take adverse employment actions
21	against an officer or employee who does not affirmatively agree

- SECTION 2. Section 46-25.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- "[f] §46-25.5[f] Expenses. Subject to section 78-6
- procedures prescribed by the director of finance of the county 7
- and approved by the mayor, all officers and employees of each 8
- county shall be entitled to travel or other necessary expenses 9
- in the performance of their official duties as provided by 10
- 11 ordinance."
- SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 12
- and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 13
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016. 14
