## A BILL FOR AN ACT

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by 1
- adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read 2

- 3 (b) A court may permit the use of a facility dog in a

- 8 (c) Before the use of a facility dog in a judicial
