## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MURDER.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Section 707-701, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1. amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: 2 3 "(1) A person commits the offense of murder in the first 4 degree if the person intentionally or knowingly causes the death 5 of: 6 More than one person in the same or separate incident; 7 (b) A law enforcement officer, judge, or prosecutor arising out of the performance of official duties; 8 (c) A person known by the defendant to be a witness in a 9 10 criminal prosecution and the killing is related to the 11 person's status as a witness; A person by a hired killer, in which event both the 12 (d) person hired and the person responsible for hiring the 13 killer shall be punished under this section; 14 A person while the defendant was imprisoned; 15 (e) A person from whom the defendant has been restrained, 16 (f) 17 by order of any court, including an ex parte order,
