A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 The legislature finds that Act 99, Session Laws SECTION 1. 2 of Hawaii 2013, established the Hawaii agriculture workforce 3 advisory board to advise the department of labor and industrial 4 relations on, among other things, projects and programs 5 recommended to promote the expansion and development of the 6 State's agricultural industry. 7 The purpose of this Act is to implement the recommendation 8 of the Hawaii agriculture workforce advisory board that the 9 State should create an agriculture workforce development 10 pipeline initiative to conduct training on all islands for 11 teachers and school administrators in agricultural self-12 sufficiency. 13 SECTION 2. Chapter 371, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated. 15 and to read as follows:
- 16 "§371- K-12 agriculture workforce development pipeline
- 17 initiative. (a) There shall be created in the department a
- 18 k-12 agriculture workforce development pipeline initiative to

- 1 conduct training sessions for teachers and school administrators
- 2 on the islands of Oahu, Hawaii, Maui, Molokai, Lanai, and Kauai,
- 3 regarding agricultural self-sufficiency.
- 4 (b) The k-12 agriculture workforce development pipeline
- 5 initiative shall be headed by a coordinator who shall be
- 6 appointed by the director, subject to chapter 76, to carry out
- 7 the purposes of this section, which may include developing and
- 8 proposing scholarships, travel offsets, course credits, and
- 9 stipends. The coordinator may hire, subject to chapter 76,
- 10 necessary staff, including a workforce development specialist,
- 11 to carry out the purposes of this section.
- 12 (c) Course material for the training sessions under
- 13 subsection (a) shall be approved by the Hawaii agriculture
- 14 workforce advisory board established pursuant to section 371-19.
- 15 (d) The department shall submit annual reports to the
- 16 legislature on the activities of the k-12 agriculture workforce
- 17 development pipeline initiative."
- 18 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000 or so much
- 20 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the
- 21 development, operation, and implementation of the k-12

- 1 agriculture workforce development pipeline initiative, including
- 2 the hiring of one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) coordinator.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
