A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPECIAL INTEREST VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "special interest vehicle"
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 ""Special interest vehicle" means a vehicle [of any age]
- 5 that, based on its model year, is at least twenty-five years old
- 6 and because of its significance, is being collected, preserved,
- 7 restored, or maintained by a collector. The term includes a
- 8 street rod vehicle and a street rod replica vehicle, as those
- 9 terms are defined in section 286-26.5 [+ a vehicle manufactured
- 10 before 1968; and a vehicle manufactured after 1967 to resemble a
- 11 vehicle manufactured before 1968]."
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take on July 1, 2050.
