A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE LOCAL AND IMMIGRANT FARMER EDUCATION PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the University of
- 2 Hawaii at Manoa college of tropical agriculture and human
- 3 resources cooperative extension service is a part of the world's
- 4 largest nontraditional education system. The cooperative
- 5 extension system is a partnership among federal, state, and
- 6 local governments. It provides science-based information and
- 7 educational programs in agriculture, natural resources, and
- 8 human resources.
- 9 Through the cooperative extension service, the University
- 10 of Hawaii at Manoa college of tropical agriculture and human
- 11 resources developed the local and immigrant farmer education
- 12 program. It consists of a team of cooperative extension service
- 13 agents and specialists that have an established network of
- 14 government and industry partners. The goals of the local and
- 15 immigrant farmer education program are to increase the viability
- 16 and sustainability of commercial farms in Hawaii, integrate more

- 1 farmers into mainstream agriculture, and help move Hawaii's
- 2 diversified industry forward.
- 3 The legislature further finds that the local and immigrant
- 4 farmer education program has a solid reputation for delivering
- 5 timely, useful, hands-on, quality extension education to
- 6 Hawaii's underserved and socially-disadvantaged agriculture
- 7 producers. However, because of a lack of federal funding, the
- 8 program faces many financial challenges.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for the
- 10 local and immigrant farmer education program of the University
- 11 of Hawaii at Manoa college of tropical agriculture and human
- 12 resources cooperative extension service to support the growth
- 13 and sustainability of the local agriculture industry.
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and
- 17 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 18 year 2016-2017 for the local and immigrant farmer education
- 19 program.
- The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
- 21 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
