## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUNTING.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the enhancement and		
2	maintenance of sustainable public hunting opportunities for		
3	subsistence and recreational purposes are of critical importance		
4	to the State and its people. A coordinated resource management		
5	effort involving stakeholders is needed to prevent and offset		
6	the loss, destruction, or degradation of public hunting areas on		
7	any island of the State and expeditiously find replacement land		
8	for hunting.		
9	The purpose of this Act is to establish a game commission		
10	to serve in an advisory capacity to the board of land and		
11	natural resources.		
12	SECTION 2. Chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
13	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
14	and to read as follows:		
15	" <u>§183D-</u> <u>Game commission.</u> (a) There is established		
16	within the department a game commission, which shall serve in an		
<b>17</b>	advisory capacity to the board. The game commission shall		

Ţ	consist o	i nine members to be appointed by the governor in the
2	manner pr	ovided in section 26-34. Membership on the game
3	commissio	n shall include one member representing each county and
4	five memb	ers at-large; provided that:
5	(1)	Each member shall be a hunter licensed in the State of
6		Hawaii under chapter 183D;
7	(2)	At least one member shall have knowledge, experience,
8		and expertise in the area of native Hawaiian cultural
9		practices;
10	(3)	At least one member shall have expertise in tourism;
11		and
12	(4)	No more than three members shall represent, be
13		employed by, or be under contract to any sector of
14		government.
15	(b)	The game commission shall select its own chairperson
16	from amon	g its members. The members shall receive no
17	compensat	ion for their services on the game commission but shall
18	be entitl	ed to reimbursement for necessary expenses, including
19	travel ex	penses, while attending meetings and while in the
20	discharge	of their duties.

1	<u>(c)</u>	The game commission may recommend policies and
2	criteria	regarding the management, protection, and promotion of
3	public hu	nting in Hawaii and may recommend amendments to
4	existing	department policies and procedures relating to hunting
5	particula	rly regarding chapter 183D and chapters 13-122, 13-123
6	and 13-12	4, Hawaii Administrative Rules.
7	<u>(d)</u>	The game commission shall:
8	(1)	Consult and advise the board on any matter affecting
9		hunting, including proposed rules and regulations;
10	(2)	Develop and evaluate a five-year game management plan
11		and any changes to the plan as necessary;
12	(3)	Establish criteria to be used in determining whether
13		an area is suitable for hunting;
14	(4)	Conduct studies of areas for sustainable yield game
15		production or enhancement;
16	<u>(5)</u>	Recommend to the board areas suitable for game
17		production or enhancement;
18	<u>(6)</u>	Recommend policies and criteria regarding the
19		management, protection, and permitted uses of areas
20		that are used for hunting;

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1	(7)	Develop ways and means to extend and strengthen game
2		management areas, other designated hunting areas, and
3		mixed-use areas within the State;
4	(8)	In carrying out its duties, consult the most
5		comprehensive up-to-date compilation of scientific
6		data;
7	<u>(9)</u>	Make recommendations relating to the process of
8		hunting rules modification;
9	(10)	Collaborate with agencies and persons who gather
10		information and implement hunting programs and data;
11		and
12	(11)	Take testimony and acquire information as it desires
13		and communicate its findings and recommendations to
14		the board.
15	(e)	Any action taken by the game commission shall be by a
16	simple ma	jority of its members. Five members shall constitute a
17	quorum.	
18	<u>(f)</u>	All meetings of the commission shall be conducted
19	subject t	o chapter 92.

1 (q) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, the game 2 commission shall be subject to sections 26-34, 26-35, 26-35.5, 3 and 26-36. 4 The department shall provide administrative support to 5 the game commission. Federal moneys and other moneys that 6 become available to the department may be used to off-set 7 administrative costs incurred by the department. 8 (i) The game commission shall submit a report to the 9 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 10 the regular session of 2016, and each regular session 11 thereafter, on its efforts to comply with this section, 12 including a summary of its activities during the year preceding 13 the regular session for which the report was prepared. 14 (j) The game commission may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to implement this section." 15 16 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the 18 19 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 20 2016-2017 for the establishment of a game commission pursuant to

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this Act.

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- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 2 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
