A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUNTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 The legislature finds that the enhancement and SECTION 1. 2 maintenance of sustainable public hunting opportunities for 3 subsistence and recreational purposes are of critical importance 4 to the State and its people. A coordinated resource management 5 effort involving stakeholders is needed to prevent and offset 6 the loss of public hunting areas and hunter opportunities on any 7 island of the State and expeditiously find replacement land for 8 hunting. 9 The purpose of this Act is to establish a game management 10 advisory commission to serve in an advisory capacity to the 11 board of land and natural resources. 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 14 and to read as follows: 15 "§183D- Game management advisory commission. (a) There 16 is established within the department a game management advisory 17 commission, which shall serve in an advisory capacity to the
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1	board. T	he game management advisory commission shall consist of
2	nine memb	ers to be appointed by the governor in the manner
3	provided	in section 26-34. Membership on the game management
4	advisory	commission shall include:
5	(1)	One member from the county of Kauai;
6	(2)	Three members from the county of Maui, with one member
7		from each of the islands of Maui, Lanai, and Molokai;
8	(3)	Two members from the county of Hawaii, with one member
9		from east Hawaii and one member from west Hawaii;
10	(4)	One member from the city and county of Honolulu;
11	(5)	One at-large member; and
12	<u>(6)</u>	The chairperson of the board of land and natural
13		resources or the chairperson's designated
14		representative, who shall serve as an ex officio
15		voting member;
16	provided	that each member, other than the chairperson of the
17	Board of	Land and Natural Resources, shall be a hunter licensed
18	in the St	ate of Hawaii under chapter 183D; at least one member
19	shall hav	e knowledge, experience, and expertise in the area of
20	native Ha	waiian cultural practices; and no more than three

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T	members sharr represent, be emproyed by, or be under contract to
2	any sector of government.
3	(b) The game management advisory commission shall select
4	its own chairperson from among its members. The members shall
5	receive no compensation for their services on the game
6	management advisory commission but shall be entitled to
7	reimbursement for necessary expenses, including travel expenses,
8	while attending meetings and while in the discharge of their
9	duties.
10	(c) The game management advisory commission may recommend
11	policies and criteria regarding the management, protection, and
12	promotion of public hunting in Hawaii and may recommend
13	amendments to existing department policies and procedures
14	relating to hunting, particularly regarding chapter 183D and
15	chapters 13-122, 13-123, and 13-124, Hawaii Administrative
16	Rules.
17	(d) The game management advisory commission shall:

(1) Consult and advise the board on any matter affecting

hunting, including proposed rules and regulations;

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1	(2)	Assist in the evaluation and development of game
2		management plans as appropriate or required and any
3		changes to those plans as necessary;
4	(3)	Assist in establishing criteria to be used in
5		determining whether an area is suitable for hunting;
6	(4)	Advise on studies of areas for sustainable yield game
7		production or enhancement;
8	<u>(5)</u>	Recommend to the board the areas that are suitable for
9		game production or enhancement;
10	(6)	Recommend policies and criteria regarding the
11		management, protection, and permitted uses of areas
12		that are used for hunting;
13	(7)	Assist the department in developing ways and means to
14		extend and strengthen game management areas, other
15		designated hunting areas, and mixed-use areas within
16		the State;
17	(8)	In carrying out its duties, consult the most
18		comprehensive up-to-date compilation of scientific
19		<pre>data;</pre>
20	(9)	Make recommendations relating to the process of
21		hunting rules modification;

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1	(10)	Collaborate with agencies and other persons who gather
2		information and implement hunting programs and data;
3	(11)	Take testimony and acquire information as it desires
4		and communicate its findings and recommendations to
5		the board; and
6	(12)	Assist the department on policies, plans, and
7		procedures related to the control of game mammals.
8	(e)	Any action taken by the game management advisory
9	commissio	n shall be by a simple majority of its members. Five
10	members s	hall constitute a quorum.
11	(f)	All meetings of the game management advisory
12	commissio	n shall be conducted subject to chapter 92.
13	<u>(g)</u>	Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, the game
14	managemen	t advisory commission shall be subject to sections 26-
15	34, 26-35	, 26-35.5, and 26-36.
16	<u>(h)</u>	The department shall provide administrative support to
17	the game	management advisory commission. Federal moneys and
18	other mon	eys that become available to the department may be used
19	to offset	administrative costs incurred by the department.
20	<u>(i)</u>	The game managment advisory commission shall submit a
21	report to	the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the

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- 1 convening of the regular session of 2017, and each regular
- 2 session thereafter, on its efforts to comply with this section,
- 3 including a summary of its activities during the year preceding
- 4 the regular session for which the report was prepared.
- 5 (j) The game management advisory commission may adopt
- 6 rules pursuant to chapter 91 to implement this section."
- 7 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the
- 10 establishment of a game management advisory commission pursuant
- 11 to this Act.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 13 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
