

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ALCOHOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of health shall conduct a 2 study regarding the risks associated with the consumption of 3 powdered alcohol products. The study shall consider: 4 Potential effects of powdered alcohol on public 5 health; 6 (2) Potential effects of powdered alcohol on crime and 7 public safety; 8 (3) Potential effects of powdered alcohol on young people, 9 including consumption by minors; 10 (4) Potential difficulties in regulating the use of 11 powdered alcohol; 12 (5) The potency of powdered alcohol in relation to liquid 13 alcohol; and 14 (6) Any other issues deemed necessary or relevant by the 15 director of health. 16 (b) The department of health shall submit a report of its **17** findings and recommendations, including any proposed

- 1 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 2 to the convening of the regular session of 2016.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 for the
- 6 department of health to conduct a study regarding the risks
- 7 associated with the consumption of powdered alcohol products.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
