A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that more emergency
- 2 services are needed in the Moanalua, Aliamanu, Red Hill, Salt
- 3 Lake, and Foster Village areas on the island of Oahu. As calls
- 4 for emergency response services increase, a greater burden is
- 5 placed on the city and county of Honolulu emergency medical
- 6 services division to respond to emergency calls in these areas.
- 7 This increased workload threatens the ability of the division to
- 8 provide acceptable levels of emergency medical services.
- 9 Moanalua, Aliamanu, Red Hill, Salt Lake, and Foster Village
- 10 are high density areas with a sizable distance between the two
- 11 nearest hospital units, Kuakini Hospital in Liliha and Pali Momi
- 12 Hospital in Aiea. In 2014 alone, these areas experienced 4,418
- 13 calls for emergency medical services. Callers often face long
- 14 response times, a problem which may worsen without additional
- 15 emergency medical services. This is evidenced by recent
- 16 statistics showing that from 2011 to 2014, the response time
- 17 slowed from 8.46 minutes to 9.4 minutes.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys to the
- 2 department of health to assist the city and county of Honolulu
- 3 emergency medical services division to expand emergency medical
- 4 services and ambulance services in the aforementioned
- 5 communities by authorizing an additional emergency medical
- 6 services unit.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
- 10 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 11 2016-2017 to assist the city and county of Honolulu emergency
- 12 medical services division to expand emergency medical services
- 13 and ambulance services in the Moanalua, Aliamanu, Red Hill, Salt
- 14 Lake, and Foster Village communities by authorizing an
- 15 additional emergency medical services unit.
- 16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 17 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060.
