
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTIETH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$700,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2015-2016
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 twentieth representative district, as follows:

7 To be expended by the department of education:

8 A. Anuenue Hawaiian immersion school, Oahu
9 Plan, design, and construct a
10 free-standing locker and shower
11 room for sports teams and physical
12 education classes.



9 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
10 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
11 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
12 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

13 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
14 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
15 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
