RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION	N 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by a	adding a new section to subpart C of part II to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:	
4	" <u>§302A</u> -	High school referees. (a) There is
5	established within the department a certification program for	
6	persons qualified to serve as referees at high school athletic	
7	events. The superintendent shall appoint an administrator for	
8	the certification program who shall be subject to chapter 76.	
9	The administrator, without regard to the public notice and	
10	public hearing requirements of chapter 91 shall:	
11	<u>(1)</u> Es	stablish and apply standards for persons to become
12	Ce	ertified as referees;
13	(2) Es	stablish and operate a process for the selection of
14	re	eferees to officiate at each high school athletics
15	er	vent; and

1	(3) Invite input, suggestions, and feedback from high
2	school athletics coaches on the implementation of
3	paragraph (2).
4	(b) The department, through its administrator, may operate
5	the certification program directly or may contract with a
6	private nonprofit organization for its operation; provided that
7	the contract shall be exempt from chapter 103D."
8	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
9	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
