A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOBACCO SETTLEMENT SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 328L-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
 "(b) The fund shall be used for the purpose of receiving,
 allocating, and appropriating the tobacco settlement moneys as
 follows:

- 6 (1) [Twenty four and one-half per cent] \$ shall
 7 be appropriated into the emergency and budget reserve
 8 fund under section 328L-3;
- 9 (2) [Thirty-five per cent] \$ shall be
 10 appropriated to the department for purposes of section
 11 328L-4;
- 12 (3) [Twelve and one-half per cent] \$ shall be
 13 appropriated into the Hawaii tobacco prevention and
 14 control trust fund under section 328L-5; and
- 15 (4) [Twenty eight per cent] <u>\$</u> shall be
 16 appropriated into the university revenue-undertakings
 17 fund [created in] under section [304A-2167,] 304A-



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1 2167.5 to be applied [solely] to the payment of the 2 principal of and interest on, and to generate required 3 coverage, if any, for $[\tau]$ revenue bonds issued by the 4 board of regents of the University of Hawaii to 5 finance the cost of construction of a university 6 health and wellness center, including a new medical 7 school facility, to be situated on the island of Oahu, for the succeeding fiscal year; and the payment of 8 9 annual operating expenses incurred by the new medical 10 school facility; provided further that any moneys in 11 excess of the amount required [to pay principal of and 12 interest on, and to generate required coverage, if 13 any, for such revenue bonds in any fiscal year,] under 14 this paragraph shall be transferred [as follows: 15 (A) To the emergency and budget reserve fund under 16 section 328L-3, eighty per cent of the excess; 17 and (B) To the Hawaii tobacco prevention and control 18 19 trust-fund-under-section 328L-5, twenty per cent 20 of the excess;] to the general fund; and
