A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HONOR AND REMEMBER FLAG.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. While war deaths have been a part of the United
- 2 States' heritage since its birth, the State of Hawaii has not
- 3 instituted an official symbol commemorating fallen
- 4 servicepersons. House Resolution 1034 of the 111th Congress
- 5 designates the Honor and Remember Flag, created by Honor and
- 6 Remember, Inc., to officially recognize and honor fallen members
- 7 of the armed forces.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to designate the Honor and
- 9 Remember Flag as a symbol for the State of Hawaii to officially
- 10 recognize and honor fallen members of the armed forces. Each
- 11 detail on the Honor and Remember Flag symbolizes an important
- 12 part of the flag's message. The red field represents the brave
- 13 men and women who sacrificed their lives for freedom. The blue
- 14 star is a symbol of active service in military conflict that
- 15 dates back to World War I. The white border recognizes the
- 16 purity of the sacrifice. The gold star signifies the ultimate
- 17 sacrifice of a warrior in active service who is not returning

- 1 home and reflects the value of the life given. The folded flag
- 2 signifies the final tribute to an individual life that a family
- sacrificed and gave to the nation. The flame symbolizes the 3
- 4 eternal spirit of the departed.
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 6
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Honor and remember flag. The honor and remember
- 9 flag is adopted, established, and designated as the State's
- 10 emblem of service and sacrifice by the brave men and women of
- 11 the United States Armed Forces who have given their lives in the
- line of duty." 12
- 13 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
