A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many county roads
- 2 are in disrepair. Drivers pay, on average, \$400 each year to
- 3 repair damage to their vehicles caused by neglected and
- 4 unmaintained roads.
- 5 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 6 funds to incentivize the repair of county roads and highways.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$12,000,000 or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and
- 10 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 11 year 2016-2017 for a grant-in-aid to the several counties for
- 12 the repair and repaving of county roads and to be allocated as
- 13 follows:
- .14 (1) City and county of Honolulu: \$3,000,000;
- 15 (2) County of Hawaii: \$3,000,000;
- 16 (3) County of Kauai: \$3,000,000; and
- 17 (4) County of Maui: \$3,000,000;

- 1 provided that no funds shall be made available to any county
- 2 unless the county provides matching funds equal to the amount
- 3 appropriated for the purposes of this Act; provided further that
- 4 the director of finance shall not release state matching funds
- 5 appropriated by this Act until all matching county funds are
- 6 encumbered by the respective county.
- 7 In addition to the matching requirement established in this
- 8 section, in order to qualify for the state matching funds as
- 9 appropriated by this Act, a county shall appropriate funds for
- 10 the repair and repaving of county roads in an amount that
- 11 exceeds the amount appropriated by the county for this purpose
- 12 in its 2014-2015 budget. Only funds that are appropriated for
- 13 repair and repaving of county roads in a county's 2015-2016 and
- 14 2016-2017 budget, respectively, that are in excess of the 2014-
- 15 2015 budget amount shall qualify for the state matching funds
- 16 appropriated in this Act. Furthermore, notwithstanding any
- 17 other law to the contrary, any state matching funds appropriated
- 18 under this section not released by the director of finance or
- 19 encumbered by a respective county by June 30, 2018, shall lapse
- 20 as of that date.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the respective
- 2 counties for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
