BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-1301, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) Not less than seventy per cent of appropriations for
- 4 the total budget of the department, excluding debt service and
- 5 capital improvement programs and appropriations for agencies
- 6 administratively attached to the department, shall be expended
- 7 by principals[-]; provided that beginning with the 2015-2016
- 8 fiscal biennium, the percentage of appropriations required to be
- 9 expended by principals shall be increased annually by two per
- 10 cent for ten years, at which point ninety per cent of
- 11 appropriations for the total budget of the department, excluding
- 12 debt service and capital improvement programs and appropriations
- 13 for agencies administratively attached to the department, shall
- 14 be expended by principals or for direct, school-related
- 15 <u>expenses.</u>"
- 16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
