## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 235-110.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) The amount of the low-income housing tax credit that
- 4 may be claimed by a taxpayer as provided in subsection (b) shall
- 5 be [fifty] one-hundred per cent of the applicable percentage of
- 6 the qualified basis of each building located in Hawaii. The
- 7 applicable percentage shall be calculated as provided in section
- 8 42(b) of the Internal Revenue Code."
- 9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030, and
- 12 apply to buildings placed in service after December 31, 2015.
