BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to amend the penal
- 2 code to support the treatment and burial of a corpse consistent
- 3 with traditional Hawaiian cultural customs and practices.
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 711-1108, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 6 "(1) A person commits the offense of abuse of a corpse if,
- 7 except as authorized by law, the person treats a human corpse in
- 8 a way that the person knows would outrage ordinary family
- 9 sensibilities[-]; provided that the treatment of a corpse for
- 10 burial in a manner consistent with traditional Hawaiian cultural
- 11 customs and practices shall not be a violation of this section."
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
