## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§302A- Fundraising and charitable activities; school
5	projects. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, nothing
6	shall prohibit a school or class from participating in
7	fundraising or charitable activities in conjunction with an
8	organization that is exempt from federal taxes under section
9	501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and
10	registered under section 467B-2.1 or granted an exemption from
11	registration under section 467B-11.5, as part of a school
12	project when the fundraising or charitable activities benefit
13	student learning pursuant to criteria established by the
14	department.
15	(b) In the implementation of subsection (a), the
16	department shall take all steps necessary to prevent:

#### Report Title:

Department of Education; Fundraising; Charitable Activity; Nonprofit Organizations; Student Learning

### Description:

Bars prohibition of student or class participation in a fundraiser or charitable activity in conjunction with a nonprofit organization as part of a school project when participation benefits student learning. Requires the department to take all steps necessary to prevent the preferential treatment of specific charities and undue pressure on school children or their families to participate in charitable activities. (HB12 HD1)
