A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the island of Oahu
- 2 currently lacks an operating motorsports center. Hawaii Raceway
- 3 Park opened for operation in Campbell Industrial Park in 1962,
- 4 but closed in 2006. Kalaeloa Raceway Park opened in 2010, but
- 5 closed in 2014. The legislature further finds that the
- 6 development of a planned motorsports center will provide a boost
- 7 of jobs in planning and construction, and provide permanent jobs.
- 8 The legislature further finds that a motorsports industry will
- 9 have a positive annual economic benefit while also resulting in
- 10 increased tourism and revenue for the State.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to require, and appropriate
- 12 funds for, the department of business, economic development, and
- 13 tourism to study and analyze the feasibility of establishing a
- 14 motorsports industry and development of a motorsports center in
- 15 Hawaii.

- 1 SECTION 2. The department of business, economic
- 2 development, and tourism shall study and analyze the feasibility
- 3 of establishing a motorsports industry and developing a
- 4 motorsports center in Hawaii, including but not limited to,
- 5 location, costs of land acquisition, costs of construction and
- 6 development, projected revenues, and means of financing.
- 7 SECTION 3. The department of business, economic
- 8 development, and tourism shall report to the legislature no
- 9 later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular
- 10 session of 2016 on findings and recommendations of its study and
- 11 analysis under section 2 of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
- 15 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 16 2016-2017 for conducting a study of the feasibility of
- 17 establishing a motorsports industry and developing a motorsports
- 18 center in Hawaii.
- 19 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 20 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
- 21 of this Act.

1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Description:

Requires Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to study and analyze the feasibility of establishing a motorsports industry and developing a motorsports center in Hawaii, including but not limited to, location, costs of land acquisition, costs of construction and development, projected revenues, and means of financing. Requires a report to the legislature. Appropriates funds. (HB1328 HD1)

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
