13	<u>(b)</u>	Any student excluded from a classroom shall be placed
14	under the	control of the principal or the principal's designee.
15	The stude	nt may be re-admitted to the classroom only after the
16	principal	, or the principal's designee, has determined that it
17	is approp	riate for the student to return to the classroom.
