## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The department of education operates Hawaii's
- 2 public school system on a \$1,700,000,000 budget that consists
- 3 primarily of funds from the State. For fiscal biennium 2013-
- 4 2015, the program costs of the department of education
- 5 constituted more than fifteen per cent of the executive branch's
- 6 total program costs.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to require a comprehensive
- 8 financial, management, and program audit of the department of
- 9 education to assist the department, board of education,
- 10 legislature, and executive branch in identifying and addressing
- 11 any issues necessary to improve the operations of the
- 12 department.
- 13 SECTION 2. (a) The auditor shall conduct a comprehensive
- 14 financial, management, and program audit of the department of
- 15 education that shall:
- 16 (1) Focus on efficiency of operations of the department of
- 17 education;



- (2) Focus on best practices for the entire department of
  education; and
- 3 (3) Identify any duplication of services and any excessive
  4 or wasteful spending by the department of education.
- (b) The audit shall be concluded no more than eighteenmonths after it begins.
- 7 SECTION 3. The auditor shall submit a report of the
- 8 auditor's findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 9 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 10 to the convening of the regular session of 2017. The
- 11 recommendations shall address any deficiencies identified as a
- 12 result of the audit.
- 13 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
- 16 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 17 2016-2017 to conduct a comprehensive financial, management, and
- 18 program audit of the department of education pursuant to section
- 19 2 of this Act.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the auditor for
- 2 the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
