### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MOTOR CARRIER LAW.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Although Hawaii's motor carrier law regulates 2 services that transport passengers by a motor vehicle on state 3 highways for compensation or hire by requiring persons providing 4 this type of service to have a certificate or permit issued by 5 the public utilities commission authorizing such activity, the 6 legislature finds that confusion has arisen as to whether ridesharing services are regulated under this law. Ridesharing 8 services offer transportation to persons using new technology, 9 including websites and phone applications, to schedule pick-ups 10 and drop-offs. As such, the legislature finds that statutory 11 language regulating motor carriers transporting passengers for 12 hire or compensation must be amended to address evolving 13 technology and its use in the provision of these services. 14 The purpose of this Act is to regulate the use of 15 ridesharing services under Hawaii's motor carrier law.

SECTION 2. Section 271-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

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amended to read as follows:

10		transportation services through the assignment of
11		motor vehicles for a continuing period of time to the
12		exclusive use of each person served, or (B) for the
13		furnishing of transportation services designed to meet
14		the distinct need of each individual customer.
15	<del>(13)</del>	"Motor carrier" includes both a common carrier by
16		motor vehicle and a contract carrier by motor vehicle.
17	<del>(14)</del>	"Private carrier of property by motor vehicle" means
18		any person not included in the terms "common carrier
19	·	by motor vehicle" or "contract carrier by motor
20		vehicle", who or which transports by motor vehicle
21		property of which the person is the owner, lessee, or

2		sale, lease, rent, or bailment, or in the furtherance

19	"Com	mission" means the public utilities commission.
20	"Com	mon carrier by motor vehicle" means any person that
21	holds its	elf out to the general public to engage in the

3	"Contract carrier by motor vehicle" means any person that
4	engages in transportation by motor vehicle of passengers or

14	"Enforcement officer" means any person employed and

6	"Motor vehicle" means any vehicle, machine, tractor,

8	and used upon the highways in the transportation of passengers
9	or property, or any combination thereof determined by the
10	commission, but does not include any vehicle, locomotive, or car
11	operated exclusively on a rail or rails or a trolley bus
12	operated by electric power derived from a fixed overhead wire,
13	furnishing local passenger transportation similar to street-
14	railway service.
15	"Online motor carrier service provider" means any company,
16	organization, group, or application that holds itself out to the
17	general public to engage in the transportation by motor vehicle
18	of passengers or property or that offers access to a motor
19	carrier for compensation via the Internet.
20	"Permit" means a permit issued under this chapter to

contract carriers by motor vehicle.

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1	"Person" or "persons" means any individual, firm,
2	copartnership, corporation, company, association, or joint stock
3	association; and includes any trustee, receiver, assignee, or
4	personal representative thereof.
5	"Private carrier of property by motor vehicle" means any
6	person not included in the terms "common carrier by motor
7	vehicle" or "contract carrier by motor vehicle", who or which
8	transports by motor vehicle property of which the person is the
9	owner, lessee, or bailee, when such transportation is for the
10	purpose of sale, lease, rent, or bailment, or in the furtherance
11	of any commercial enterprise.
12	"Rates" includes rates, fares, tolls, rentals, and charges
13	of whatever kind and nature unless the context indicates
14	otherwise.
15	"Transportation network company" means a corporation,
16	organization, group, or sole proprietor, that provides
17	prearranged transportation services for compensation using an
18	application or app to connect passengers with drivers using
19	their personal vehicles.
20	"Transportation of persons" includes every service in
21	connection with or incidental to the safety, comfort, or

- 1 convenience of persons transported and the receipt, carriage,
- 2 and delivery of these persons and their baggage.
- 3 "Transportation of property" includes every service in
- 4 connection with or incidental to the transportation of property,
- 5 including in particular its receipt, delivery, elevation,
- 6 transfer, carriage, ventilation, refrigeration, icing, dunnage,
- 7 storage in transit, handling, and its consolidation for the
- 8 purposes of forwarding within the State."
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 271-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 "\$271-8.5 Advertising. (a) It shall be a misdemeanor for
- 12 any person, including a person who is exempt under section 271-
- 13 5, to advertise as a motor carrier of passengers or property,
- 14 unless the person holds a valid certificate or permit required
- 15 by this chapter as to the classification so advertised. The
- 16 term "advertise", as used in this section, includes: [the]
- 17 (1) The issuance of any card, sign, or device to any
- 18 person[<del>, or the</del>];
- 19 (2) The causing, permitting, or allowing of any sign or
- 20 marking on or in any building or motor vehicle[--or
- 21 the-]; or

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(c) Upon notice from the public utilities commission ofthe entry of a final order of the commission pursuant to chapter

91 or a judgment by a court of competent jurisdiction, that a

- 2 section 271-8, the public utility furnishing the
- 3 telecommunications service or an online motor carrier service
- 4 provider shall disconnect that person's access to the
- 5 application, telephone number, or telecommunications service
- 6 number contained in the advertisement or listing. A public
- 7 utility or online motor carrier service provider complying with
- 8 a notice to disconnect is immune from liability for damages
- 9 resulting from its compliance.
- (d) The publisher or producer of a print or broadcast
- 11 advertising medium, or online motor carrier service provider,
- 12 shall not be liable in any suit, action, or claim arising from
- 13 its refusal to list or accept advertisements pursuant to
- 14 subsection (b)."
- 15 SECTION 4. Section 271-38, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 "\$271-38 Enforcement. (a) At the request of the public
- 18 utilities commission, the department of transportation shall
- 19 assign a motor vehicle safety officer employed by the department
- 20 of transportation to assist in the enforcement of sections 271-

- 1 8, 271-12, 271-13, 271-19, and 271-29, through the assessment of
- 2 civil penalties as provided in section 271-27(h), (i), and (j).
- 3 (b) The commission may contract with qualified persons
- 4 including investigators who shall be exempt from chapter 76 to
- 5 enforce this chapter. The investigators of the commission shall
- 6 have the power to serve and execute warrants or issue citations
- 7 to enforce the provisions of this chapter. Whenever the
- 8 existence of an illegal operation is discovered, the inspector
- 9 may make a complaint to the district judge in whose circuit the
- 10 operation is located, and the district judge shall allow a writ
- 11 of injunction to abate and prevent the continuance of the
- 12 illegal operation."
- 13 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
