A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended as follows: 3 By amending subsection (a) to read: 4 "(a) There shall be a commission to be known as the King 5 Kamehameha celebration commission placed within the department 6 of accounting and general services for administrative purposes. 7 The commission shall consist of thirteen members to be appointed 8 by the governor in the manner provided by section 26-34. 9 appointments shall be made from the following organizations, **10** with at least one member from each organization: 11 Royal Order of Kamehameha I; (1) 12 (2) 'Ahahui Ka'ahumanu; 13 (3) Hale O Nā Ali'i O Hawai'i 'Ahahui Po'o; 14 (4)Daughters and Sons of Hawaiian Warriors; 15 Kamehameha Schools Alumni Association: (5) 16 Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs; (6)

Waimanalo [Homesteaders] Hawaiian Homestead

- 1 (8) Kapahulu Music Club; [and]

- 4 In addition, the governor shall appoint one member from

- 14 contributions, and private donations.] state funds."
- 15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
- 18 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 19 2016-2017 for the operating cost of the King Kamehameha
- 20 celebration commission.
