A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to subpart C of part IV to be		
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:		
4	"§302A- Promotional materials; community events;		
5	nonprofit organizations. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the		
6	contrary, upon appropriate approval, public schools may use		
7	school resources to distribute to students and their families		
8	third party promotional materials that contain information about		
9	a community event or are produced by or offer services from an		
10	organization that is exempt from federal taxes under section		
11	501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and		
12	registered under section 467B-2.1 or granted an exception from		
13	registration under section 467B-11.5; provided that the		
14	promotional materials:		
15	(1) Have a clear and specific benefit for students;		
16	(2) Closely align with the department's educational		
17	mission; or		

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1	(3)	Demonstrably advance the implementation of the
2		department's strategic plan.
3	(b)	Approval to distribute materials pursuant to
4	subsectio	n (a) shall be obtained at the school level for
5	distribut	ion limited to certain grade levels or specific
6	geographi	c areas. To obtain approval at the school level:
7	(1)	The school principal seeking approval shall review the
8	•	materials and recommend approval to the complex area
9		superintendent; and
10	(2)	The complex area superintendent shall approve, in
11		writing, the recommendation for distribution.
12	(c)	Approval to distribute materials pursuant to
13	subsectio	n (a) shall be obtained from the department for state-
14	wide dist	ribution at all schools. To obtain department
15	approval:	
16	(1)	An assistant superintendent or office director shall
17		review the materials and recommend approval to the
18		superintendent; and
19	(2)	The superintendent, or the superintendent's designee,
20		shall approve, in writing, the recommendation for
21		distribution.

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1	(d) If approval to distribute materials is granted, each
2	school principal shall have the discretion to determine whether
3	and to what extent to distribute the material and to determine
4	an appropriate distribution method."
5	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
