A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part VII to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§321- Sale of beverages as part of a children's meal.
- 5 (a) A children's meal sold or offered for sale at any food
- 6 establishment shall include only bottled water or low-fat milk
- 7 as a beverage option included in the price of the children's
- 8 meal. No other beverage option shall be included in a
- 9 children's meal without an additional charge and no discount
- 10 shall be provided for any other beverage option contingent upon
- 11 purchase of a children's meal.
- 12 (b) Any person who violates this section shall be subject
- 13 to a fine of not less than \$ per violation nor more than
- 14 \$ per violation.
- 15 (c) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
- 16 91 to implement this section.
- 17 (d) For purposes of this section:

1	"Children's	meal"	means	any	combination	of	food	and

- 2 beverage items sold for a single, comprehensive price that is
- 3 primarily marketed to, intended for, or sold to children
- 4 years of age or younger."
- 5 SECTION 2. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 6 application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held
- 7 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 8 applications of the Act that can be given effect without the
- 9 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 10 of this Act are severable.
- 11 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
