

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) The director of transportation shall	
2	conduct a	feasibility study on the construction of an	
3	alternati	ve access road to be built mauka of Farrington highway	
4	beginning at Lualualei Naval Magazine road that provides access		
5	into and	out of the leeward coast of Oahu. The study shall	
6	include a	t least the following:	
7	(1)	A cost-benefit analysis of establishing this mauka	
8		alternative access road;	
9	(2)	Identification and evaluation of desired, intended,	
10		and possibly unintended effects of establishing this	
11		mauka alternative access road;	
12	(3)	A timetable for the construction of this mauka	
13		alternative access road;	
14	(4)	Identification and evaluation of any other potential	
15		alternative access routes into the leeward coast that	
16		would be more cost-beneficial than this mauka	
17		alternative access road;

Ţ	(5)	A review of previous studies conducted to identify	
2		alternative access routes and determine the	
3		feasibility of establishing these routes into and out	
4		of the leeward coast; and	
5	(6)	Any other issues deemed necessary or relevant by the	
6		director of transportation.	
7	(d)	The director of transportation shall submit a written	
8	report of	findings and recommendations, including any necessary	
9	proposed	legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty	
10	days prio	r to the convening of the regular session of 2016.	
11	SECT	ION 2. There is appropriated out of the general	
12	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000 or so much		
13	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the		
14	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
15	2016-2017 for a feasibility study on the construction of an		
16	alternative access road to be built mauka of Farrington highway		
17	beginning at Lualualei Naval Magazine road that provides access		
18	into and out of the leeward coast of Oahu.		
19	The	sums appropriated shall be expended by the department	
20	of transp	ortation for the purposes of this Act.
