

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) The director of transportation shall
2	conduct a	study examining the feasibility of establishing a
3	fifth lan	e of travel on the ocean side of Farrington highway in
4	Nanakuli	from Kahe point to Mohihi street, to be used for
5	contraflo	w during rush hour and requiring relocation of the
6	existing	railroad. The study shall consider:
7	(1)	A cost-benefit analysis of establishing the fifth
8		contraflow lane and relocating the existing railroad;
9	(2)	Identification and evaluation of desired, intended,
10		and possibly unintended effects of establishing this
11		fifth contraflow lane and relocating the existing
12		railroad;
13	(3)	A comprehensive review of previous West Oahu traffic
14		flow studies and any other factors the director deems
15		appropriate and relevant, such as:
16		(A) Communities and areas of Oahu affected;

1		(B)	Population densities and growth of those						
2			communities;						
3		(C)	Existing patterns and trends in traffic flows and						
4			densities;						
5		(D)	Existing peak and off-peak usage and flows under						
6			varying conditions, including seasonal and						
7			weather considerations;						
8		(E)	Peak carrying capacity of Farrington highway and						
9			the surrounding feeder highways and roads at						
10			current usage patterns; and						
11		(F)	All these patterns compared with projected						
12			patterns and usage if a fifth contraflow lane is						
13			established;						
14	(4)	A review of alternatives for improving regional							
15		conn	connectivity and reducing travel time; and						
16	(5)	Any other issues deemed necessary or relevant by the							
17		dire	ctor of transportation.						
18	(b)	The	director of transportation may consult with the						
19	various c	ounti	es and any other agency or private entity that it						
20	deems app	ropri	ate to conduct the study.

1 SECT	ION 2.	The	director	οf	transportation	shall	submit	а
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- 2 report of findings and recommendations of the feasibility study,
- 3 including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later
- 4 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
- 5 of 2016.
- 6 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000 or so much
- 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 for the
- 9 feasibility study required by this Act, including the retention
- 10 of necessary and appropriate consultants and professionals.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.

Description:

Appropriates moneys for the director of transportation to conduct a feasibility study regarding the establishment of a fifth lane of travel on the ocean side of Farrington highway in Nanakuli from Kahe point to Mohihi street, to be used for contraflow during rush hour and requiring relocation of the existing railroad.

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
