BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 346-44, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 3 "§346-44 Recovery of public assistance overpayments. (a)
- 4 All overpayments of public assistance funds, including [but not
- 5 limited to overissuances of financial assistance, [food stamp
- 6 bonuses under a food stamp plan, supplemental nutrition
- 7 assistance program assistance, medicaid assistance, and
- 8 incorrect vendor payments in behalf of a recipient, shall
- 9 constitute a debt due and owing to the department by the
- 10 recipient of [such] the overpayments. In addition to the
- 11 remedies elsewhere prescribed in this chapter for the recovery
- 12 of assistance fraudulently obtained, recovery of all
- 13 overpayments $[\frac{\text{will}}{\text{shall}}]$ be made to the $\frac{\text{maximum}}{\text{maximum}}$ extent
- 14 allowable by federal regulations.
- 15 (b) The department shall [promulgate] adopt and enforce
- 16 [such] rules [and regulations] consistent with subsection (a) as
- 17 may be necessary to effect the maximum recovery of public

- assistance overpayments, including [but not limited to] the 1
- maximum reduction of future public assistance grants. 2
- Departmental rules [and regulations] for the recovery of 3
- overpayments shall prescribe procedures for recourse to the 4
- civil courts when required, the filing of liens against the real 5
- property of overpaid recipients, and the filing of claims 6
- against the estate of a deceased recipient who has received 7
- overpayments [which] that have not been recovered. Nothing in 8
- this section shall preclude the director of human services from 9
- [promulgating] establishing procedures for waiving the recovery 10
- of overpayments in cases of bona fide hardship or where the 11
- costs of recovery would exceed the amount expected to be 12
- 13 recovered."
- SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 14
- and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 15
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 16
