A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 302A-251, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

5 the 2011-2013 school years, all public schools, excluding
6 charter schools and multi-track public schools, shall implement
7 a school year of one hundred eighty days, excluding professional

Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary: 10 (b) (1) For the 2011-2012 school year, fifty per cent of all 11 public elementary schools in the State, excluding 12 13 charter schools and multi-track public schools, shall implement a school year that includes nine hundred 14 fifteen student instructional hours; and 15 Beginning with the 2012-2013 school year, all public 16 (2) elementary schools in the State, excluding charter 17

1 schools and multi-track public schools, shall 2 implement a school year that includes nine hundred 3 fifteen student instructional hours. 4 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, [for] (C) beginning with the [2014-2016] 2015-2016 school [years,] year, 5 all public secondary schools, excluding charter schools and 6 7 multi-track public schools, shall implement a school year that 8 includes nine hundred ninety student instructional hours. 9 [(d) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, for the 2016-2018 school years, all public schools, excluding 10 11 charter-schools and multi-track public schools, shall implement 12 a school year of one hundred eighty days, excluding professional 13 development days and other non-instructional days negotiated pursuant to chapter 89, that shall include one thousand eighty 14 student instructional hours for both-elementary and secondary 15 16 school grades. 17 The board, in its discretion, may grant a waiver (e)] (d) 18 to any individual school subject to the student instructional 19 hours or one hundred eighty day school year requirements in this

20 section. The board shall adopt policies and procedures to grant 21 a waiver under this subsection.

Applies the requirement for all public secondary schools to implement a school year that includes 990 student instructional hours to all school years beginning with the 2015-2016 school year. Repeals the requirement that by the 2016-2018 school years, all public schools implement a school year of 180 days and 1,080 student instructional hours for both elementary and secondary school grades. Clarifies that the definition of "student instructional hours" shall be determined by the board of education in consultation with the exclusive representatives of the appropriate bargaining units.
