A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-251, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§302A-251 School year; [instructional] student [time.] 4 (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, beginning with the 2011-2013 school years, all public schools, 5 6 excluding charter schools and multi-track public schools, shall 7 implement a school year of one hundred eighty days, excluding 8 professional development days and other non-instructional days 9 negotiated pursuant to chapter 89. 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary: 11 (1) For the 2011-2012 school year, fifty per cent of all

- (1) For the 2011-2012 school year, fifty per cent of all public elementary schools in the State, excluding charter schools and multi-track public schools, shall implement a school year that includes nine hundred fifteen student [instructional] hours; and
- (2) Beginning with the 2012-2013 school year, all public
 elementary schools in the State, excluding charter

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1	schools and multi-track public schools, shall
2	implement a school year that includes nine hundred
3	fifteen student [instructional] hours.
4	(c) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, [for]
5	beginning with the [2014 2016] 2015-2016 school [years,] year,
6	all public secondary schools, excluding charter schools and
7	multi-track public schools, shall implement a school year that
8	includes nine hundred ninety student [instructional] hours.
9	(d) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, for the
10	2016-2018 school years, all public schools, excluding charter
11	schools and multi-track public schools, shall implement a school
12	year of one hundred eighty days, excluding professional
13	development days and other non-instructional days negotiated
14	pursuant to chapter 89, that shall include one thousand eighty
15	student [instructional] hours for both elementary and secondary
16	school grades.
17	(e) The board, in its discretion, may grant a waiver to
18	any individual school subject to the student [instructional]
19	hours or one hundred eighty day school year requirements in this
20	section. The board shall adopt policies and procedures to grant
21	a waiver under this subsection.

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For purposes of this section, "student [instructional] 1 2 hours" [means student learning time during which students are 3 engaged in learning activities including regularly-scheduled 4 instruction and learning assessments within the curriculum, and 5 does not include lunch, recess, or passing time.] shall be 6 defined by the board in consultation with the exclusive 7 representatives of the appropriate bargaining units. 8 The department of education, with the board of 9 education and office of the governor, and in consultation with 10 representatives of the affected collective bargaining units, 11 shall submit to the legislature no later than twenty days prior 12 to the convening of the regular sessions of 2013, 2014, 2015, 13 2016, 2017, and 2018, a report on its progress and efforts to 14 meet the requirements of subsections (a), (b), (c), and (d)." SECTION 2. Act 167, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, as 15 amended by Act 52, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, is amended by 16 17 repealing section 4. ["SECTION 4. The department of education shall, with the 18 19 board of education and office of the governor, and in 20 consultation with representatives of the affected collective 21 bargaining units, submit to the legislature, no later than

- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.

Report Title:

Department of Education; Student Hours

Description:

Applies the requirement for all public secondary schools to implement a school year that includes 990 student hours to all school years beginning with the 2015-2016 school year. Requires that by the 2016-2018 school years, the 180-day school year requirement include 1,080 student hours for both elementary and secondary school grades. Clarifies that the definition of "student hours" is to be determined by the Board of Education in consultation with the exclusive representatives of the appropriate bargaining units. (HB14 HD1)

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
