- SECTION 1. Section 269-106, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: "(b) Credits for excess electricity from the eligible
- 4 customer-generator that remain unused after each twelve-month
- 5 reconciliation period may not be carried over to the next
- 6 twelve-month period[-], but shall be placed in a reserve fund
- 7 established by the public utilities commission to offset the
- 8 <u>electricity</u> bills of consumers who can verify that they receive
- 9 public assistance from the department of human services."
- 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
