A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EARLY SETTLERS OF AFRICAN ANCESTRY, THEIR HAWAIIAN AFRICAN DESCENDANTS, AND PEOPLE OF AFRICAN DESCENT IN HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. People of African ancestry made numerous
- 2 significant contributions to all phases of Hawaii's development
- 3 and history since their arrival in the eighteenth century.
- 4 Combined with the rich culture of Native Hawaiians, people of
- 5 African ancestry continue to impact and influence life in
- 6 Hawaii, particularly with the President of the United States,
- 7 Barack Obama, being a Hawaii born person of African ancestry.
- 8 Hawaii can no longer ignore the early settlers' history which
- 9 has been embedded in the fabric of these islands long before the
- 10 missionaries arrived in 1820, with the descendants of these
- 11 settlers still living among us today.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to establish a commission to
- 13 recognize the history of the early settlers of African ancestry
- 14 and Hawaiian African descendants, acknowledging their many
- 15 contributions and common threads within Hawaii's society and to



- 1 educate local residents and young people about the diverse
- 2 culture and roots within our islands' multicultural society.
- 3 SECTION 2. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 4 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 "S6E- Hawaii commission on the history and culture of
- 7 the early settlers of African ancestry and their Hawaiian
- 8 African descendants. (a) There is established a commission to
- 9 be known as the Hawaii commission on the history and culture of
- 10 the early settlers of African ancestry and their Hawaiian
- 11 African descendants.
- 12 (b) The commission shall be temporarily placed within the
- 13 office of the governor for administrative purposes.
- 14 (c) The commission shall consist of eleven members to be
- 15 appointed by the governor without regard to section 26-34. The
- 16 members may include:
- 17 (1) Two members representing the African American
- 18 Diversity Culture Center Hawaii;
- 19 (2) Two members representing the National Association for
- 20 the Advancement of Colored People;
- 21 (3) One member representing the University of Hawaii; and
