
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to part X to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 Flagger training and certification. (a) No "§286-5 person shall provide temporary traffic control in a street, 6 road, or highway unless the person completes training and is 7 certified by a program that meets the training and certification 8 standards of the National Safety Council highway flagger 9 training program, the American Traffic Safety Services 10 Association flagger program, or an equivalent program that meets 11 the same objectives. A program shall not be deemed to be an 12 equivalent program unless it meets the United States Department 13 of Transportation Federal Highway Administration standards for 14 the control of traffic through highway work zones, as defined in 15 the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for streets and 16 highways.

5	(c) This section shall not apply to law enforcement

8	highway, regardless of the ownership of the street, road, or
9	highway."
10	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
12	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
13	begun before its effective date.
14	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
