# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THEFT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 445-231, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
3	and to read as follows:
4	""Urn" means a container that is or has been used to hold
5	human ashes."
6	SECTION 2. Section 445-233, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	amended as follows:
8	1. By amending subsection (b) to read:
9	"(b) If the scrap presented for purchase is copper, [ <del>or</del> ] a
10	beer keg, or an urn, in whole or in part, the seller shall
11	provide a copy of a receipt that describes, with particularity:
12	(1) The exact item that is being offered for sale;
13	(2) Who issued the receipt;
14	(3) The date of sale of the item prior to the item's being
15	offered to the scrap dealer; and
16	(4) The price, if any, of the item when obtained by the
17	seller."

## H.B. NO. H.D.

- 1 2. By amending subsections (d), (e), and (f) to read:
- 2 "(d) If the seller does not provide a copy of the receipt
- 3 or the notarized declaration as required by subsections (b) and
- 4 (c), the scrap dealer shall not purchase the copper, [ex] beer
- 5 keg, or urn in whole or in part, and shall report the attempted
- 6 sale to the police.
- 7 (e) If the scrap dealer purchases any copper, [or] beer
- 8 keg, or urn, in whole or in part, the scrap dealer shall take a
- 9 photograph or photographs of all of the copper, [or any] beer
- 10 keg, or urn, offered for sale.
- 11 (f) The scrap dealer shall also require the seller to
- 12 verify the seller's identity by presenting a valid photo
- 13 identification card or license issued by a federal or state
- 14 government agency authorized to issue valid identification. If
- 15 the scrap being offered for sale is copper, [ex] a beer keg, or
- 16 an urn, in whole or in part, the scrap dealer shall:
- 17 (1) Take a photograph of the seller; or
- 18 (2) Make a photocopy of the identification card or license
- of the seller."

## H.B. NO. 1578 H.D. 1

- 1 SECTION 3. Chapter 708, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§708- Theft of urn. (1) A person commits the offense
- 5 of theft of urn if the person commits theft of an urn.
- 6 (2) For the purposes of this section, "urn" means a
- 7 container that is or has been used to hold human ashes.
- 8 (3) Theft of urn is a class C felony."
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 11 begun before its effective date.
- 12 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

#### Report Title:

Urn; Statement; Theft; Penal Code; Class C Felony

## Description:

Requires scrap dealers to follow the same regulations regarding a written statement for the purchase of an urn as they do for the purchase of copper or a beer keg. Establishes the offense of theft of urn as a class C felony. (HB1578 HD1)
