

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 304A, part IV, subpart A, subdivision								
2	1, Hawaii	Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section								
3	to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:									
4	" <u>§30</u>	4A- Community college tuition waiver. The board of								
5	regents s	hall waive the tuition of any person who enrolls as a								
6	student in a community college under the following conditions:									
7	(1)	The person is a United States citizen or an eligible								
8		non-citizen, as determined by the board;								
9	(2)	The person has been a resident of the State for at								
10		least twelve months prior to the time of applying for								
11		the waiver;								
12	(3)	The person is a graduate of a private or public high								
13		school located in the State;								
14	(4)	The person is admitted to and enrolled full-time in a								
15		community college;

1	(5)	The person maintains satisfactory academic progress,						
2		as determined by the community college in which the						
3		person is enrolled;						
4	(6)	The person maintains continuous full-time enrollment						
5		at a community college, except for periods of medical						
6		or personal leave of absence, as approved by the						
7		community college that the person attends;						
8	<u>(7)</u>	The person is physically present in the State; and						
9	(8)	The person is under the age of twenty-six."						
10	SECT	ION 2. (a) The University of Hawaii shall implement						
11	section 1	of this Act as a pilot project in any county with a						
12	population of less than one hundred thousand people, beginning							
13	in the fall of 2017. In addition to the requirements set fort							
14	in sectio	n 1, and notwithstanding any conflicting requirements						
15	set forth in section 1, the board of regents shall waive the							
16	tuition c	f any person who enrolls as a student in a community						
17	college i	n a county with less than one hundred thousand people						
18	under the	e following conditions:						
19	(1)	The person completes and submits to the board of						
20		regents a Free Application for Federal Student Aid;

2		leas	st two y	/ears	<b>5</b> ;							

- 3 (3) The person attended high school for at least two
  4 years; and
- 5 (4) The person graduated from a high school located in the6 county.
- 7 (b) The board of regents shall submit a report of its
- 8 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 9 legislation, on the outcomes of the tuition waiver program to
- 10 the legislature not less than twenty days prior to the convening
- 11 of the regular session of 2019.
- 12 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016;
- 14 provided that section 1 shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
